ADVENT BIBLE READING CHALLENGE

If someone observed an average day in your life, how would they see you spend your time? How much of your time is given to TV, Facebook, YouTube, podcasts, hobbies, and housework? How much time do you devote to Bible reading?

The challenge to you is that during Advent you undertake to read the whole of the bible!

Advent this year Starts on Sunday 3rd December and lasts until Sunday 24th December– that's 22 days.

It takes the average reader 74 hours to read the whole bible so to undertake the full challenge means devoting just over 3 hours a day to the task. That may seem a lot, but the average person in the UK watches TV for 4 hours and 28 minutes a day. We all say there's nothing to watch but we still do. Why not press the off button and devote your time to the challenge!

Not enough time? Too busy? Don't cop out!

If you can't undertake the full challenge, try this...

Undertake to read the Gospels and Acts during Advent.

It takes the average reader around 17 hours to read the Gospels and Acts ...that's less than an hour a day during Advent.

If you can't take the whole challenge, why not design your own Bible reading challenge for Advent.


